REQUIRED Documentation for Registration below.

Have these ready before you start your application. You can use your phone to take a picture of the documents and then upload them. They need to be uploaded for the application to be approved.

- Photo ID or passport for each applying adult
- Birth certificate **OR** Medicaid card for all children in the household
- Custody papers as applicable
- Current food stamp award letter (not the card) **OR** proof of all monthly income and expenses
- Proof of Catawba County residency
- Info. for all children in household 17 & under (still in school).

Once you submit your application, please allow up to two weeks to receive confirmation that your application has been approved and your appointment for pickup set during distribution.
